Gidon was born in Karlovy Vary, (Karlsbad) Czechoslovakia in 1935. When he was 6, Gidon and his family were sent to the Terezin concentration camp; only Gidon and his mother survived. After liberation, Gidon lived in Toronto, Canada, and in 1959, he came to Israel and was a kibbutznik for many years. He served in the IDF, married and raised five children. A mischief maker at heart, Gidon delivers flowers, attends political protests and has committed at least one act of vandalism on a political billboard.
